Dear Pepperoni Roll Enthusiast!

The **West Virginia State Folk Festival** is a tradition every June, beginning the third Thursday. Dr. Patrick Gainer began the festival in 1950. It was officially chartered in 1961. Folk Festival involves the sharing of West Virginia traditions like old stringed music, dance, crafts, and storytelling.

In 2021, the birth of the **West Virginia State Pepperoni Roll Championship** brought a new aspect to this collection of West Virginia traditions. On March 4, 2020 the West Virginia State Senate declared this event the official State Championship for the pepperoni roll recipe in a resolution written by Gilmer County Girl Scouts, who created the Championship as part of their Girl Scout Silver Award Project.

We are looking for competitors and sponsors for our fourth annual West Virginia State Pepperoni Roll Championship to be held during West Virginia State Folk Festival in Glenville, WV on Saturday, June 21, 2025. Competitors will bring six pepperoni rolls for blind judging competition (all six *must* fit in a 9x9 take-out tray), and another two dozen+ individually wrapped to sell to the public. The registration fee is a donation of \$25. The proceeds from the competition fees and sale of pepperoni rolls will go toward the cost of hosting the event this year, and for years to come.

Individuals and businesses are invited to participate with their favorite traditional pepperoni roll recipe.

Prizes will once again include beautiful locally handmade plaques and cutting boards for First, Second, and Third place winners, plus inclusion in a press release to be shared state-wide.
